Brief description of education and work experience:

Jamie S. Ostroff, Ph.D. is Associate Attending Psychologist and Chief, Behavioral Sciences Service, in the Department of Psychiatry & Behavioral Sciences, Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center. She serves as Director of Memorial Hospital's Smoking Cessation Program, a hospital based cessation program for cancer patients and their families. Dr. Ostroff received her doctorate in Clinical Psychology from Vanderbilt University, Nashville TN. She completed her clinical internship at the Robert Wood Johnson Medical Center in New Brunswick, NJ and her postdoctoral fellowship in Psych-Oncology at the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, New York. She has published over 80 peer-reviewed papers focusing on the behavioral and psychological aspects of cancer prevention and control, with specific expertise in tobacco cessation in health care settings and the psychological and behavioral issues associated with prevention, early detection and long-term management of patients with tobacco-related cancers. She has been the PI or Co-PI on 12 NIH grants. Her work has also been supported by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, the American Cancer Society, the Lance Armstrong Foundation and the Legacy Foundation. She is also the Director of Research Training and PI of a NCI-supported institutional training grant in psychosocial, community and palliative care issues in cancer.
